## Submission

The workshop aims at bringing together promising young scholars working on topics related to economic policy in complex environments. The call is open to doctoral candidates and recent graduates (who received the title in 2023) in economics or related disciplines. We welcome both theoretical and empirical contributions on, but not limited to, the following topics:

- Heterogeneous and adaptive expectations
- Network theory and social networks
- Agent-based simulation and estimation
- Behavioural economics
- Advanced methods for statistical inference
- Climate change mitigation and adaptation
- Low carbon transition
- Innovation policy
- Global value chains
- Environmental economics

When submitting, authors will be asked to select one of the following three areas that best fits their work: Methodological Advances, Climate Policy and Innovation Policy. Applicants can apply by filling out the submission form and upload an extended abstract according to the provided guidelines. Submissions will be evaluated by a scientific committee.
